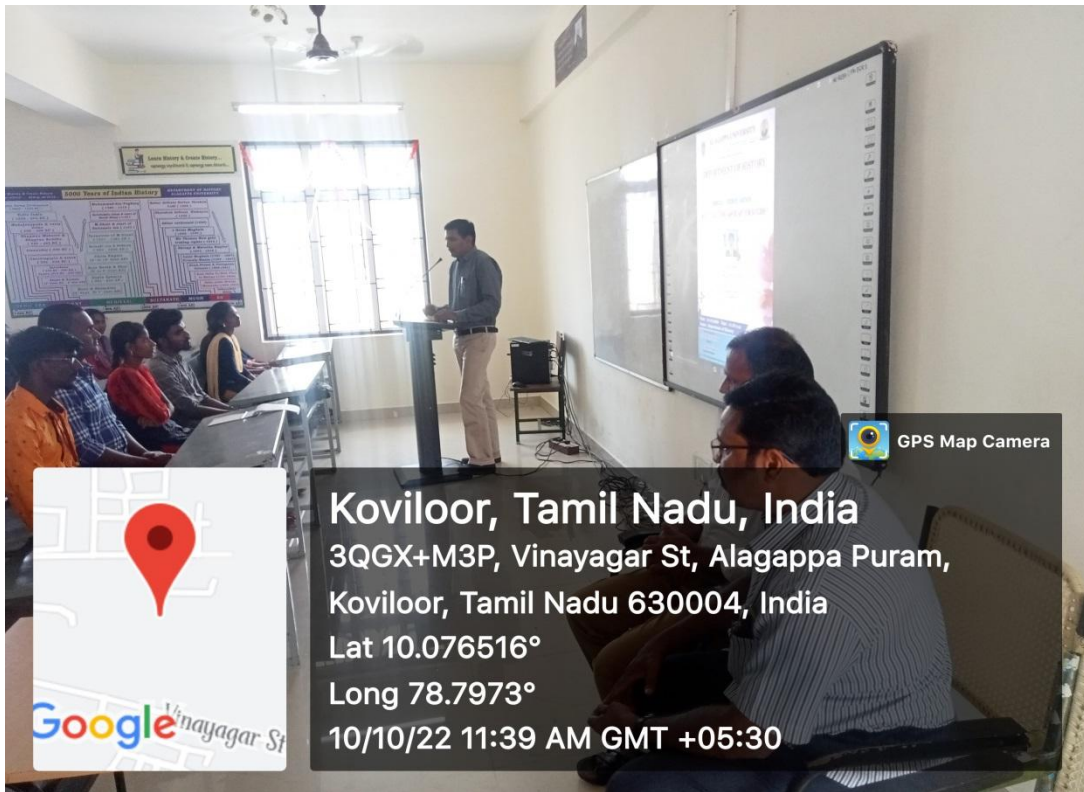

Why is Education important for Success?

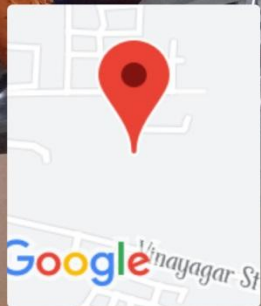

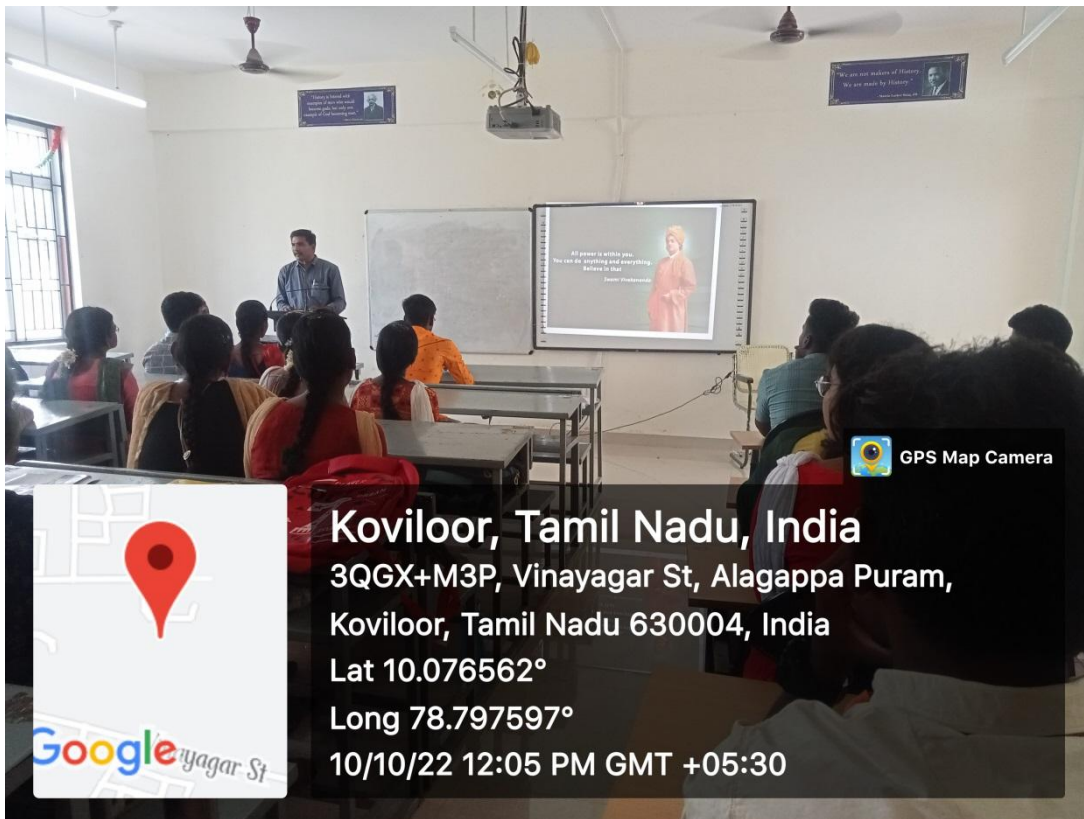

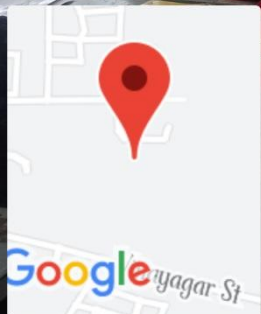
