

Inaugural Session:

On the Behalf of Alagappa University, Department of Social Work conducted Training for trainers programme on BONDED LABOURERS on 30.10.2023 in Conference Hall, Department of Social Work.

Dr. MA. Velusamy, Head In charge delivered a Welcome Speech. Sivaganga, Assistant Commissioner of Labour Enforcement Mrs. I. Muthu delivered a thematic address. In her speech, she specially mentioned that rescue cases of bonded labourers in her period of service. She listed out the Articles & Schemes related to Bonded labourers to give beneficial to students. Sivaganga, Deputy Inspector of Labour Enforcement Mr. Velayutham addressed about the bonded labourer by explaining real rescue incidents.

Department of Social Work, Alagappa University organized a Webinar Series-II on 25.09.2023.




