




VILLAGE EXTENSION PROGRAMME – VADAGUDI – 10.03.2023 to 12.03.2023

First Day: 10.03.2023

The first-day Programme was inaugurated at 10.30 am on 10.03.2023 in Vadagudi Panchayat Council office. For this inauguration programme, Vadagudi Panchayat President - Mr. Bala Subramanian, Dr. N. Johnson, Head i/c, Department of Lifelong Learning and Dr. M. Neethiperumal, Teaching Assistant, Department of Lifelong Learning, Alagappa University were present and conveyed their wishes to the students.
