Invited Talk

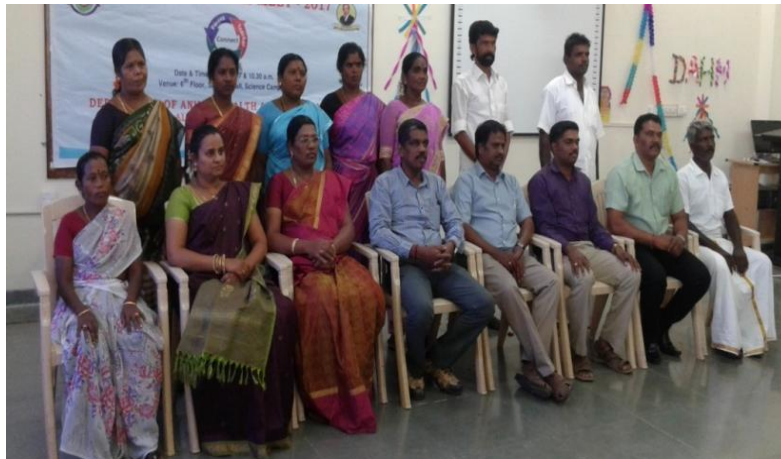

Village Extension Programme, (VEP) Alampattu, Kallal Village

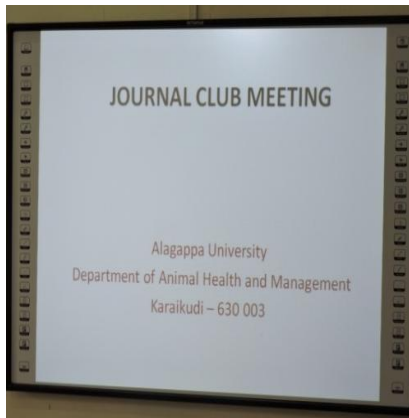

In 2022, students from the Department of Animal Health and Management visited the Southern Regional Research Centre located in Mannavanur, Kodaikanal.



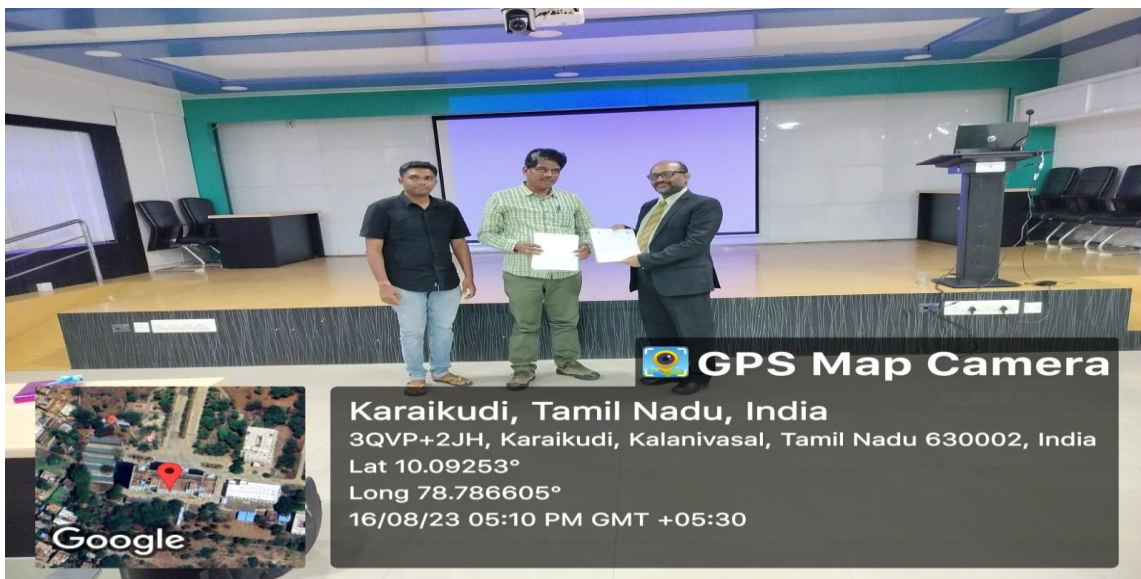
