Minutes of the Meeting of the IQAC held on 10th October 2019 at the Syndicate Hall of Alagappa University

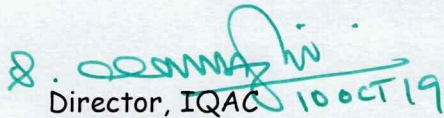
