For the academic year 2018-19, Alagappa University has decided to adopt one department developed one village for the VEP. Department of Animal health and management were assigned a village called Sankarapuram village, which is a socially and financially deprived hamlet.

The Real Hamlet- 'Sankarapuram'

Sankarapuram is an area developed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the habitation or rehabilitation of majority Mutharaiyar Caste people in Sankarapuram village under Sakkottai Panchayat, Sivaganga district, Tamil Nadu. Sankarapuram is located around 8 kms from Karaikudi very close to the National Highways connecting Rameswaram.

Day 1 – (11.10.2018) – The day for “Environment and Yoga”
