Resolutions

1. Resolved that the reconstitution of the IQAC and the conduct of regular post-accreditation meetings be placed on record as a reaffirmation of the institution's commitment to structured quality governance.
2. Resolved to record deep appreciation for the collective efforts of the University fraternity – faculty, staff, students, alumni and stakeholders – in securing the A++ Grade with a CGPA of 3.594 in the 4th Cycle of NAAC Accreditation. This remarkable achievement reflects the University's sustained commitment to quality, excellence, and continuous improvement and the IQAC commends the leadership and teamwork that made this distinction possible.
3. Resolved to implement the recommendations of the NAAC Peer Team through the respective cells, clubs, and units of the University: Placement Cell shall strengthen placement initiatives; Alumni Association shall enhance alumni engagement; SWAYAM Cell shall promote the use of SWAYAM and SWAYAM PRABHA channels; Departments shall introduce bridge courses for soft skills; International Affairs Cell shall work towards internationalisation; Research and IPR Cell shall strengthen IPR and R&D initiatives; Consultancy Cell shall promote industrial consultancy; Fine Arts/Media Unit shall work towards infrastructure for theatre and film studies; and IQAC shall co-ordinate the integration of LMS into the teaching-learning process.
4. Resolved to redesign the Academic Audit formats in alignment with the revised NAAC Accreditation Framework to capture both qualitative and quantitative indicators, with emphasis on teaching-learning, research outcomes, student support and OBE compliance.

5. Resolved to conduct Academic Audit across all teaching departments annually using the revised formats. The audit will promote self-assessment, accountability and quality improvement.
6. Resolved to revamp all curricula through broad-based Boards of Studies with representation from industry experts, alumni, researchers, and external academics to ensure relevance to NEP 2020, employability and global standards.
7. Resolved to revive Value-Added Courses for the academic year 2025-26 across all faculties, focusing on employability skills, entrepreneurship, innovation and holistic student development.
8. Resolved to reconstitute the Student Council for the academic year 2025-26 in accordance with framework of NAAC to promote student participation in governance, leadership and quality assurance initiatives.

The meeting concluded with a reaffirmation of the University's commitment to sustaining the A++ Grade and pursuing continuous quality enhancement in all domains.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the IQAC Director.
