Minutes of the Meeting of the IQAC held on 31st July 2025 at the Syndicate Hall of Alagappa University.

The IQAC Director presented a report on the quality enhancement initiatives undertaken by the IQAC in the post-accreditation period following the award of A++ Grade (CGPA 3.594) by NAAC in the 4th Cycle. The Chairperson, Prof. G. Ravi, Vice-Chancellor, presided over the meeting and appreciated the range and depth of quality initiatives. After deliberation, the Committee passed the following resolutions:

Resolutions

1. Resolved that the Teachers' Feedback Form on Curriculum be periodically refined to ensure that inputs are meaningful, specific and actionable for curriculum improvement.
2. Resolved that Faculty Development Programmes focusing on curriculum advancement, research excellence and professional empowerment be organised periodically to enhance faculty competencies and teaching-learning quality.
3. Resolved that competitive examination awareness programmes – including GATE and JAM – be organised level to improve student awareness and institutional performance in national examinations.
4. Resolved a new Institutional Portrait be prepared to present an accurate, comprehensive and current profile of the University's academic standing, research output, rankings and achievements.
5. Resolved that the University actively participate in national and international awards and recognition programmes and that nominations be prepared and submitted by IQAC in a timely and professional manner.

6. Resolved that presentations representing the University at national and international educational summits and forums be prepared by the IQAC with care, reflecting the institution's vision, achievements, and future aspirations.

7. Resolved that a Manual of Duties and Responsibilities of Administrative Staff be prepared and periodically updated to strengthen institutional governance, administrative accountability and role clarity.

8. Resolved that Academic Audit and Administrative Audit with revised formats be conducted across all departments and support units to promote self-assessment, transparency, and accountability in administrative functioning.

9. Resolved that the Student Satisfaction Survey be conducted for 2025-26 across all programmes and that the findings be analysed and acted upon by the respective departments.

10. Resolved that all draft MoUs proposed by University departments with external agencies be routed through the IQAC for vetting, to ensure quality, compliance, and alignment with institutional objectives before signing.

11. Resolved that the IQAC verify and sign the Plagiarism Detection Reports as part of the institutional approval process, thereby upholding academic integrity standards across all research submissions.
