The 70th Republic Day was celebrated at Alagappa University in Karaikudi with usual fervour and gaiety.



Prof.N.Rajendran, Vice-Chancellor, hoisted the National Flag and accepted the guard-of-honour given by the N.C.C. students and security staff of the University.

In his Republic Day Address, the Vice-Chancellor said that the most significant characteristics enshrined in the Indian Constitution such as freedom, equality, brotherhood, secularism, pluralism and unity-in-diversity should be respected and given due importance by all citizens. Social Justice and economic independence have to be protected for preserving an egalitarian society. In India 25% of rural population and 14% of urban population are living below the poverty line. Growth, he said, should be inclusive and encompass all sections of the Indian society. The developmental activities should reach all citizens who are in need of them. Employment -generating education is the need of the hour and towards which the Universities are concentrating today; and in particular Alagappa University, which is ranked at the 2nd

position among the State Universities in India, and in the first place in Tamil Nadu, strives to provide quality education and encourages socially relevant research.
